

## Conor Daly collects Champions Trophy



Although he is still young enough to compete in the junior class, on Friday evening in Las Vegas, Cytomax driver Conor Daly collected his trophy for winning the senior TaG east championship at the Stars of Karting awards banquet.

After a season long battle of ten races in five different states, Conor secured the championship with a dominating performance on his Top-Kart at Shawano Raceway, Wisconsin in September, where he qualified on the pole for both finals, set fastest race laps in each race and finished first and second.

Although he was again the fastest of all in qualifying for the National finals on Saturday in Las Vegas, electrical problems at the start of the third heat race (having won the second heat) and at the start of the second final race took him out of contention for the overall National title.

Conor's next race will be the SKUSA Super Nationals in Las Vegas November 14<sup>th</sup> – 18<sup>th</sup> where he will go against 80 of the best TaG class drivers in the country in a one weekend shoot out. (The TaG class uses a 125cc water cooled clutch drive engine).

Conor Daly, son of former Formula One/Indy Car driver turned TV commentator Derek Daly, races for the Grand Products Top Kart team in the Stars of Karting championship in addition to the Skip Barber Racing series. Conor races his karts exclusively on Bridgestone tires and is sponsored by Cytomax Performance Drink, INDECK Forsythe Racing, Pedigo Chevrolet, The College Network, Tom Lange Company and Alpinestars.
