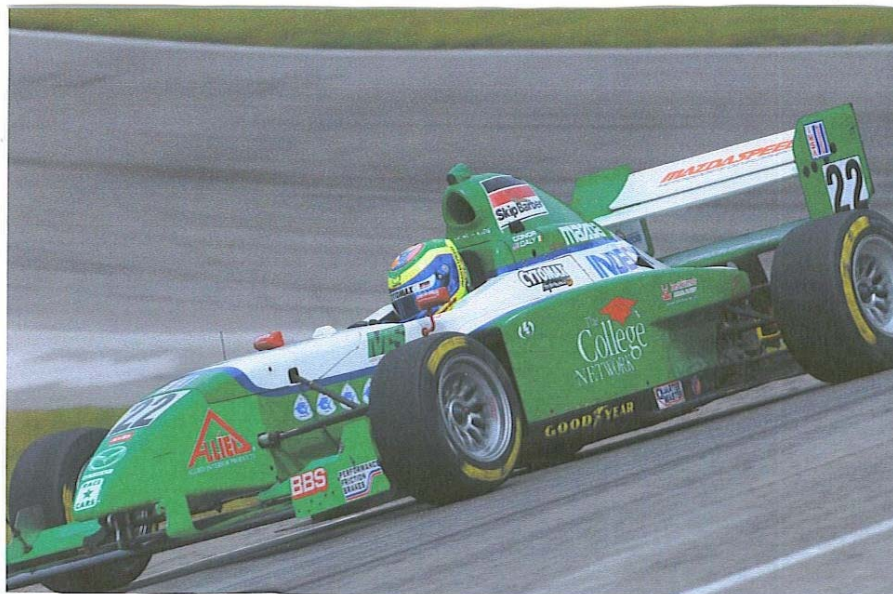

Daly, the son of former Formula One and CART driver Derek Daly, has turned as many heads in Europe as in the United States. He is having a strong first season in the Star Mazda Series, where he

sits fourth in points and has scored a win from the pole at New Jersey Motorsports Park for Anderson Racing.

Daly broke onto the international scene last fall when he, along with Josef Newgarden, won events at the U.K. Formula Ford Festival. Daly took the prestigious Walter Hayes Trophy at Silverstone.

Former Champ Car team owner Gerry Forsythe is Daly's primary backer, and the driver is focused on either British Formula Renault or British Formula Three next season. Managed by his father, Daly also wants to compete in the Firestone Indy Lights race at Indianapolis Motor Speedway. He is on the new U.S. F1 team's radar as a potential future driver.
